Anna Rose is a trained architect with a specialism in urban design, masterplanning and public realm design. She has extensive international experience advising both private and public sector clients in design development and planning processes of public realm aspects of projects of all scales.

She trained at RWTH Aachen, Germany and as an exchange student at the Bartlett School of Architecture, University College London.

Anna has lectured to architectural and landscape design audiences both in the UK, EU and USA. She is a Senior Honorary Research Fellow of University College London and is currently teaching Urban Design in the MArch Urban Design programme at the Bartlett.

Position & Role

Anna joined Space Syntax as a project consultant in 2002, and became a Director in 2007. She has been involved in a large number of UK masterplans, including Birmingham Eastside, Harlow North, Camden Canal Market and Bristol St Pauls. She has been leading the work on the Ljubljana Smartinska Masterplan and on the Jeddah Central Urban Area Masterplan.

She has also contributed to a number of important public space projects, including Potters Field Park in London and Old Market Square in Nottingham. Current work on highprofile, mixed use developments includes Elizabeth House in London, Waterloo and 120 Fenchurch Street in the City of London.

Anna is a member of the UK Academy of Urbanism. She leads the company's activities in the EU with a particular focus on the German speaking markets.
